Organization Summary:

Valiant Hearts is on a mission to restore and empower sexually exploited women through compassionate care and healing. We offer holistic help and customized care including emergency housing, support groups, mentorship, education, and more!

Since 2011, we've served sexually exploited women from the Dallas-Fort Worth area and are one of few organizations providing stabilization for women in crisis. Our goal is to walk alongside survivors of exploitation and trafficking as they begin a journey of healing and restoration. We want these brave women to know that we are with them for the long haul!

Who are we looking for?

We are searching for someone who has a heart to work with the broken hearted. We are looking for a compassionate person who is emotionally healthy and strong to walk alongside women who need a safe shoulder to lean on in some of their most vulnerable moments. This role is crucial to the work we do with residents primarily because you will live in the home (for 5 months) and provide direct support to residents during your scheduled hours.

Part of this role will also be a victim's first interaction with Valiant Hearts as you will occasionally respond to crisis intake calls. It is important that the person for this role knows how to communicate effectively and efficiently with the team and with the residents we serve. We expect a teachable spirit, team playing attitude, and adaptability. It is important that the person for this role always prioritize the residents' safety and comfort while handling crisis situations in a calm and victim-centered approach.

Should you apply?

1. Are you able to maintain healthy boundaries while also being approachable, flexible, and adaptable?
2. Are you someone that others have described as “safe,” “trustworthy,” “relational,” and “compassionate?”
3. Do you have what it takes to stay calm in a high pressure situation and help others find balance and peace?
4. Do you draw energy from being around others?

- Provide supervision, basic needs, and emotional support for survivors on some evenings and weekends
- Guide residents in life-skills training such as preparing and cooking meals, hygiene, and self-care.
- Communicate effectively and timely with the Case Manager
- Ensure the residents adhere to the daily schedule and routine
- Clean, maintenance, and organize the Cherished House
- Provide ongoing support for the Cherished Program (support group, special events, etc)
